

**Bach-analia**, a weekend fundraising event to benefit the 36<sup>th</sup> annual Oregon Coast Music Festival will be held March 29 and 30, 2014. The featured artist at both events is Priscilla Dantas, a Brazilian piano prodigy with talent beyond her years. She took her first piano lesson at nine and was the subject of a Brazilian national television news report at eleven. In 2007, when she was fourteen, she was soloist with the Recife Symphonic Orchestra, performing Mozart's Concert in C. Currently a junior on scholarship at the University of Oregon, Ms. Dantas excels in academics and piano. Her free time is spent performing benefit concerts throughout Oregon and Brazil to help fund her education.

Ms. Dantas will perform at a house concert Saturday, March 29 at 7pm. A lovely Coos Bay home will be the relaxed, informal setting for an evening of music as it was meant to be experienced. This is a potluck, bring a dish and beverage to share. Seating is limited, don't wait to contact the OCMA office at 541-267-0938 to make reservations and then learn the location.

Sunday, March 30 at 2pm the second Bach-analia event with Ms. Dantas will be held at the Emmanuel Episcopal Church 400 Highland, Coos Bay, OR. Pricilla Dantas will also present a Kinder Konzert event at North Bend High School on Monday March 31 to share her love of classical music with some of our youth with musical interests.
