Festival Music Director James Paul and guest conductor Jonathon Tessero will take audiences on a trip to the Great White Way through the music of Broadway hits spanning decades.

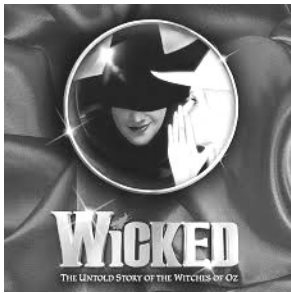
